

P-Listed Pharmaceutical Waste

The EPA's P-List identifies acutely hazardous waste from discarded products, including trace amounts found in empty containers and other packaging. Depending on state regulations, your facility may determine to collect and ship P-listed pharmaceuticals separately from other hazardous waste pharmaceuticals.

▶ Patient Care facilities including Hospitals, Rehabilitation Centers and Oncology Centers



▶ Chemotherapy Research, Testing and Facilities

Items that are P-Listed Hazardous Pharmaceuticals



▶ Warfarin / Coumadin* medication and wrappers



▶ Pharmaceutical grade nicotine

▶ Phsyostigmine
Trisenox Injections/Arsenic Trioxide

LARGE QUANTITY GENERATOR

If a facility generates more than 2.2 pounds of P-listed waste at any time, the US EPA considers the facility to be a Large Quantity Generator.
